Temple Shaarei Shalom Programs & Activities Descriptions

Committees:

Caring Committee will help and support each of our members as we experience the events, stages, and transitions of life.

Family Engagement Committee will assist families and students to become socially connected with other people at the temple and encourage participation in the many opportunities for involvement at the temple.

Israel Programming Committee will develop & facilitate Israel focused programs to insure our connection with Israel remains strong.

Legacy Committee is responsible for developing and implementing the Endowment Development Program. The Committee will provide structure and the process designed to stimulate interest in establishing a strong financial future.

Membership Recruitment Committee works to develop programs for recruiting and welcoming new members.

Membership Retention Committee works to develop programs for integrating new members and retaining current members.

Ritual Committee works with the Ritual Chair and assists Clergy with all aspects of religious services and rituals, inviting people for pulpit honors, and assisting with Minyans.

Social Action Committee serves as a liaison between the Temple and community on all matters of social action and social justice.
